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## **TEACHING STAFF**

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## Choice Based Credit Semester System (CCSS)

Kannur University has implemented CCSS from 2009 admission for Under Graduate Courses. The Degree Programme is for a period of 3 years consisting of 6 Semesters. The odd semester shall be held from June to October and even semester from December to March. April and May will be vacation.

The Degree Programme include four types of Courses viz-

- (A) Common Course**
- (B) Core Course**
- (C) Complementary Course**
- (D) Open Course.**

The Programme consists of 30 Courses with 120 credits.

A student shall be permitted to appear for the semester examination only if he/she secures not less than 75% attendance in each semester. Condonation of shortage of attendance for a maximum of 12 days for a maximum of two spells within the programme may be granted. Those students who are not eligible for condonation or having shortage of attendance more than 12 days shall repeat the course along with subsequent batch.

The Evaluation Scheme for each course contains two parts: Continuous Evaluation (CE) and End Semester Evaluation (ESE). 25% weight shall be given for Continuous Evaluation and 75% weight for End Semester Evaluation.

End Semester Evaluation is conducted by University. The evaluation of answer scripts are done by external examiners.

There shall be five grades namely A, B, C, D, E according to the performance of students. A student who secures a grade other than E in a course is permitted to register within 14 days after the declaration of results for re-examination for improving the performance in the subsequent chance. The internal grade already obtained will be carried forward to determine the new grade in the re-examination. If the candidate fails to appear for improvement examination after registration, or if there is no change/upgradation the grade obtained in the first appearance will be retained. There shall not be more than one chance for improvement.



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Appearance for Continuous Evaluation and End Semester Evaluation are compulsory and no grade shall be awarded to a candidate if he/she is absent for CE/ESE or both. Minimum D grade is required for pass in a course in End Semester Exams. But successful completion of a semester requires a minimum Semester Grade Point Average(SGPA) of 1.5. However a student is permitted to move to next semester irrespective of SGPA. A student can improve his/her result by reappearing for End Semester Evaluation of any course of the semester concerned along with the examination for subsequent admission. An overall letter grade for the whole Programme shall be awarded on the basis of value of CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average). For the successful completion of a programme and award of the degree a student must complete all semesters successfully.

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## Choice Based Credit Semester System (CCSS)

2014 Admission onwards

The regulation provided herein shall apply to all regular undergraduate programmes conducted by Kannur University, for the UG Programmes/admissions commencing from 2014, with effect from the academic year 2014 - 2015. The Degree Programme is for a period of 3 years consisting of 6 Semesters. The odd semester shall be held from June to October and even semester from December to March. April and May will be vacation.

The Degree Programme include four types of Courses viz-

- (A) Common Course
- (B) Core Course
- (C) Complementary Course
- (D) Open Course.

A student shall be permitted to appear for the semester examination only if he/she secures not less than 75% attendance in each semester. Those students who are not eligible for condonation shall repeat the course along with subsequent batch.

The Evaluation Scheme for each course contains two parts: Internal Assessment (IA) and End Semester Evaluation (ESE). 20% weight shall be given to the Internal Assessment and remaining 80% weight shall be for the End Semester Evaluation.

There shall be University examinations at the end of each semester. A candidate fails to register for University Examination shall not be permitted to move to the next semester.

Improvement of courses in a particular semester can be done only once.

End Semester Evaluation is conducted by University. The evaluation of answer scripts are done by external examiners.

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## Indirect Grading System

Indirect grading system based on a 7-point scale is used to evaluate the performance of students. Each student is evaluated by assigning marks with a letter grade ( A+, A, B, C, D, E and F) to that course by the method of indirect grading. A candidate securing E grade with 40% of aggregate mark and 40% seperately for ESE for each course shall be declared to have passed in that course. Appearance for Internal Assessment (IA) and End Semester Evaluation (ESE) are compulsory and no grade shall be awarded to a candidate if she/ he is absent for IA/ESE or both. A student fails to secure a minimum E grade for a pass in a course is permitted to write the examination along with the next batch. After the successfull completion of a semester, Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA)of student in that semester is calculated.

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## ADMISSION

Application for admission to various degree-courses should be in online. The duly filled in application should be submitted through Kannur university website within the prescribed time and date.

The allotment list of selected candidates will be exhibited on the University Website. It is the duty of the candidates to verify whether they are in the allotment list and to ascertain the date and time of interview. Representation for admission based on late receipt will not be entertained.

Candidates should produce the following documents at the time of interview.

1. Secondary School Leaving Certificate
2. The mark List of Plus Two or equivalent examination.
3. Transfer and Conduct Certificates from the institution last attended.
4. Three Passport size Photographs.
5. Proficiency Certificate, if any, in Sports/Games /NSS/ Illiteracy Eradication Programme.
6. In the case of those who are eligible for fee concession, the Income, Nativity and Community Certificate from the village officer concerned.
7. In the case of Ex-servicemen and their dependants certificate from the competent authority.
8. In the case of SC and ST students they have to produce Community and Nativity Certificates from the Tahsildar

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## COLLEGE RULES

### (a) General Rules

- ✍ Students are expected to wear uniform/neat and decent dress and behave in a polite and decorous manner.
- ✍ Students are prohibited from:-
  - ✍ Entering the classrooms, laboratories, office, staffroom etc. except when they are expected to be there.
  - ✍ Loitering on verandas and in vacant classrooms.
  - ✍ Smoking within the college premises.
  - ✍ Damaging furniture and other college property.
  - ✍ Holding meetings and processions without obtaining the prior permission of the Principal.
- ✍ Perfect discipline and decorum should be maintained in the classroom and in the college campus.
- ✍ No student shall leave the class before the teacher leaves.
- ✍ For acts of misbehaviour, the Principal may impose punishment such as fine, cancellation of attendance, withholding of certificate, forfeiture of educational concession and scholarships, suspension and expulsion.
- ✍ Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones to the campus. Fine will be imposed to those who bring mobile phone to the college.
- ✍ Students have to submit an undertaking that they are ready to obey the rules of the college; they will not indulge in violence and will not commit crimes like ragging, destruction of individual and institutional property.
- ✍ Every student has to participate in any one of the co-curricular activities.
- ✍ A fine shall be levied on students caught for destruction of individual or institutional property. If the particular student is not identified, a common fine will be imposed.
- ✍ Students should bring and wear the ID Card issued by the College during the college working hour and produce before teachers as and when necessary. A fine will be imposed for non-compliance with regard to ID Card.

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- ✎ No individual or groups are allowed to boycott classes.  
Boycotting classes or such strikes are prohibited.

**(b) Fee Rules**

1. Tuition fee can be paid in full or three terms. Special fees and first term tuition fees will be collected on the date of admission. The annual income limit for fee concession is Rs-.25000/- per annum for Degree courses and 1 lakh for PG courses .
2. If a student fails to pay fee on the due date, he/she shall be liable to pay a fine of Rs.5/- along with the fees on or before the 10th day of the month concerned.
3. If the fee with the fine is not paid even on the 10th day after the due date, an additional fine of Rs.10/- will have to be paid.
4. Caution deposit collected from the student will be refunded after deducting dues, if any, at the completion of the course or when the student leaves the institution, whichever is earlier, on production of the receipt.
5. If the fees and the fine are not paid within the last working day previous to the date of the succeeding instalment, the name of the student will be removed from the roll of the college. If he/she is to be re-admitted, he/she has to apply for special permission to the principal with the recommendation of the concerned tutor and HOD.

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### (c) Attendance Rules

- ✎ No student shall be absent from his/her class without leave.
- ✎ A student who is absent from the class for 1 hour will be considered absent for that session.
- ✎ The certificate of attendance required by the university for admission to University examination will not be granted unless the Principal is satisfied that the students conduct and progress have been satisfactory.
- ✎ Every student shall put in a minimum attendance of 75% of the total number of working days in each semester.
- ✎ A student who is absent without leave for more than 15 consecutive working days will be removed from the roll.
- ✎ Students participating in co-curricular activities should submit an attendance eligibility certificate from the teacher in charge of the co-curricular activity for every month not later than 5th of the following month, to the tutor.
- ✎ Application for leave on grounds of illness shall be supported by a Medical Certificate.
- ✎ Students seeking exemption from the rules related to minimum attendance shall apply for condonation to the university through the Principal. Every application shall be made in the prescribed form, copies of which can be had from the university. The reason for each day's absence is to be explained. In the case of absence due to illness, medical certificate has also to be furnished. In no case shall condonation be granted to a student more than twice during a course.

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## (d) Library Rules

- ✎ All the students of the college are the members of the library.
- ✎ They are entitled to borrow books on production of library tickets which will be issued by the librarian.
- ✎ Duplicate card will be issued only on payment of a penalty of Rs. 25/-
- ✎ Degree students can borrow 3 books at a time and P.G students can borrow 6 books
- ✎ Books will be issued between 9.30 a.m and 4.p.m
- ✎ Books shall be returned within a fortnight and renewal of books will be allowed twice only.
- ✎ Absence from the college will not be considered as an excuse for delay in returning books.
- ✎ The librarian may recall a book at any time even before the expiry of the period of loan.
- ✎ Members shall not sub-lend the books of the library.
- ✎ On no account shall a member disfigure or damage a library book.  
When a member gets a book from the library, he/she shall satisfy himself that the book is in good condition. If it is not, the matter should promptly be brought to the notice of the librarian.
- ✎ A fine of Rs.1/- per day will be levied, if a book is kept beyond a fortnight.
- ✎ If the date of return of the book happens to be a holiday, it shall be returned on the following day.
- ✎ No students are expected to be in the library during class hours.
- ✎ Students have to produce identity cards if demanded by the librarian while they are in the library.

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## (e) Issue of Certificates

- ✍ Application for certificates should be made atleast two days in advance. A fee of Rs.10/- shall be collected for the issuance of certificate.
- ✍ Conduct certificate will ordinarily be issued only along with the transfer certificates when the student has completed the course.
- ✍ A fee of Rs.5/- per page will be charged for issuing a certified copy of any document.
- ✍ A fee of Rs.10/- will be charged for issuing a duplicate of any certificate.
- ✍ No certificate will be issued from the college unless the Principal is satisfied with the reason stated by the applicant for the issue of such a certificate.
- ✍ Application for transfer certificate should be made in the pre-scribed form
- ✍ A good conduct certificate will not be issued to students who are found guilty of misbehaviour.

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## **CO –CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

### **THE COLLEGE UNION**

The college union is intended to promote the social and cultural life of the student, to train them in the rights and duties of citizenship and to provide them with opportunities to develop their personalities and skills. All students of the college are by right members of the college union and they elect the office bearers who include the chairman, the vice-chairman, the general secretary, the joint secretary, the university union councillor, the fine arts secretary, the general captain, the student editor and the class representatives. The college union is guided by staff advisor, appointed by the principal. The college union should work irrespective of caste, colour, community and political separation.

### **NAM ARTS FORUM (NAMAF)**

An Arts Forum is functioning in the college to promote the artistic and literary talents of the student community and to encourage their participation in competition at various levels, including the University Festival. The duly elected Fine Arts Secretary will be the student Co-ordinator of the Arts Forum.
